1. Major and minor research projects by the faculties:

2. Innovations in Curricular Design and Transaction:

 - d. Orientation and Mobility Science;
 - e. Boxing

to be framed and necessary grading and certificates shall be issued to the at the end of the academic year.

- iv) The following new subjects are to be included as elective subjects:
 - a. Sports Journalism and Information Science
 - b. Sports Sociology
 - c. Guidance and Counselling
 - d. Adapted Physical Education
 - e. Professional preparation/SLET and NET/TRBE
 - f. Environmental science.

3. Examination Reforms:

IQAC has decided to have the intensive coaching lesson practice for M.P.Ed-I and II years. The Elective subjects for Master degree shall be modified and professional preparation for NET/SLET to be introduced in Objective type and subjective type pattern (E2101).
