ORDER

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

- AND WHEREAS, the institution YMCA College of Physical Education, 333, AnnaSalai, Nandanam, Chennai-600035, Tamilnadu has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for 100 intake in B.P.Ed.
- 3. AND WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have one basic unit of 100 students (two sections of 50 each) subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely,
 - The institution shall submit all the documents and FDRs of the existing course including recognition order issued earlier and the latest affiliation order by 30.06.2015.
 - The institution shall appoint additional staff as per Regulations, 2014 and submit approved staff list to the Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
 - The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, check adher ance by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with the new teaching staff requirements, the institution shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
- 4. NOW THEREFORE, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) (a) of NCTE, Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to YMCA College of Physical Education, 333, AnnaSalai, Nandanam, Chennai-600035, Tamilnadu for conducting B.P.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of one basic unit of 100 (two sections of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-16 subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned here in before 31.10.2015.
- **5.** Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University/Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.
- 6. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self- Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 7. The institution shall maintain & update its web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure:
 - a) Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution:

b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.

c) Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter:

d) Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.:

e) Fee charged from students;

f) Available infrastructural facilities;

g) Facilities added during the last quarter;

h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;

i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.

j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information. if it so desires.

k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

If the institution Contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

ORDER

In exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(1) of the National Council For Teacher Education (NCTE) Act, 1983, the Southern Regional Committee grants recognition to YMCA College of Physical Education, Mandanson, Chennal-500 035, Tamilnadu for H.C.P.Ed. course of one year duration from the ecademic session 2000-2001 with an annual intake of 40, subject to fulfilling the following conditions:



- 1. Documentary proof for having appointed qualified teaching staff to be produced within a week.
- 2. The recognition accorded is subject to the condition that the certificate given by the State of Tamilnadu will be valid for employment within Tamilnadu only and that the duration and admission criteria are those that exist in the State of Tamilnadu prior to the promulgation of the NCTE Act. The institution is permitted to conduct the course of one year duration upto 2005 only. Thereafter the course has to be switched over to two years as per NCTE norms.
- 3. The Institution shall have adequate teaching staff possessing the academic quatrications as laid down in the NCTE norms, in the salary structure prescribed by the UGC/Central Government/State Government as the case may be.
- 4. Documentary proof for having appointed qualified teaching staff to be produced within a week
- The Institution shall ensure library, laboratories and other instructional infrastructure as por NCTE norms.
- 6. The admission to the approved course shall be given only to those candidates who are eligible as per the regulations governing the course and in the manner laid down by the affiliating University / State Government as the case may be

University / State Government as the case may be tall such time NCTE regulations in respect of fee structure come into force.

- 8. Curriculum transaction, including practical work / activities, should be organised as per the course and the requirements of the affiliating University / examining body as the case may be
 - 9 Teaching days Including practice reaching should not be less than the number fixed in the NCTE norms for the course.

- 10. The institution, if unalded, shall maintain endowment and reserve fund as par norms
- 11. The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the State Government as stated above and NCTE norms wherever applicable and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The performance appraisal report should inter alla give the extent of compilance of the conditions indicated above.

| YMCA College of Physical Education, Nandanam, Chennal-600 035, Taumilinadia contravenes the provisions of the NCTE Act or the rules, regulations and orders made or issued thereunder or fails to fulfill the above conditions, the Regional Committee may withdraw this recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

ORDER

WHEREAS in terms of Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 The National Council of YMCA's of India, Chennai-600035, Tamilnadu has submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to YMCA College of Physical Education, No.333, Anna Salai, Nandanam, Chennai-600035, Tamilnadu for M.P.Ed(Additional Intake) course of two years for an additional intake of 30(Thirty) Students.

- AND WHEREAS on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the 2. documents attached therewith the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, the Committee is satisfied that the institution fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratories etc for running the programme and has appointed duly-qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.
- Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the 3. NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to YMCA College of Physical Education, No.333, Anna Salai, Nandanam, Chennai-600035, Tamilnadu for conducting M.P.Ed(Additional Intake) course of two years duration with an annual intake of 60(Sixty) students which includes the existing intake of 30(Thirty) and an additional intake of 30(Thirty) under clause 7(12) of Regulations dated 13.01.2006. This order of recognition shall be prospective and take effect from the date of issue of this order, subject to fulfillment of the following:
 - The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, i) convert the endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
 - The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards ii) prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.

- The institution will ensure that <u>Principal and Seven</u> faculty members duly approved by The Registrar, Tamilnadu Physical Education and Sports University, Chennai, are in position for an intake of <u>60</u> students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately.
- Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / bodies, State Government etc, as applicable.
- The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a <u>Self-Appraisal Report at</u> the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- 6. The institution shall maintain & update the Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations.
- 7. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.
